Nursing Care Field Clinical Trials Register Up and Running!

We are pleased to announce that our Nursing Care Field Clinical Trials Register is up and running and is now available on Cochrane's Register of Studies. It is located in the NursingcareField database.

The CNCF Trials Register contains references of Randomised Control Trials and other relevant trial reports within the scope of the field. The aim of the CNCF is to make the trials register available to the wider nursing community to inform nursing practice and for researchers to identify gaps in nursing knowledge.
